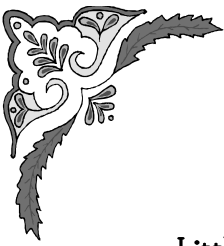

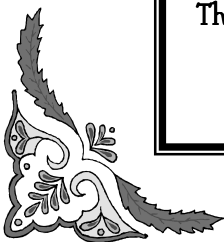

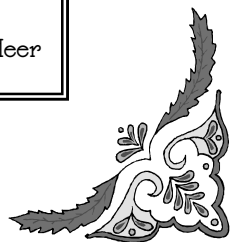

Mr. Smith's involvement with little league began in 1963 when he coached his oldest son's T-shirt division team at a field at North Merritt Island little league. He started the idea of building a ball field here for the players living on South Merritt Island. With the support of Mr. Ed Mixon, principal at Tropical Elementary, and Mr. Percy Hedgecock, school board member, land was secured and the building could begin. Here's where Mr. Smith really went to work. He assembled a core team of volunteers who took hold of his dream and with him, worked tirelessly on the creation of the field originally here. His shared vision helped to provide the children of South Merritt Island with the best possible facility. Over the years, he was also involved with the S.M.I.L.B. Board of Directors as President (1979-1980), and with officiating games up to 1998.

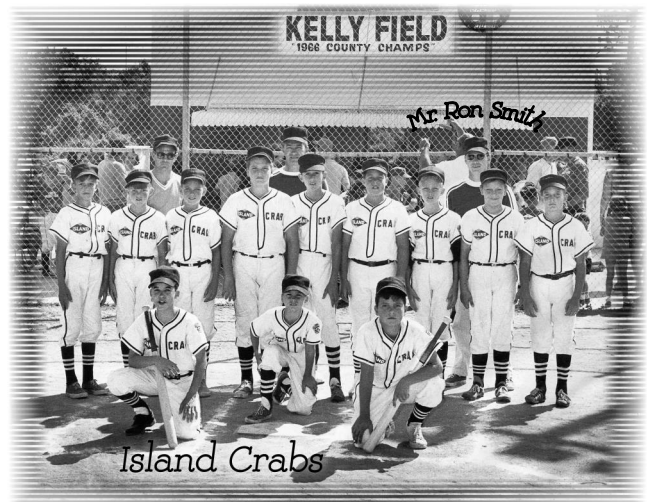

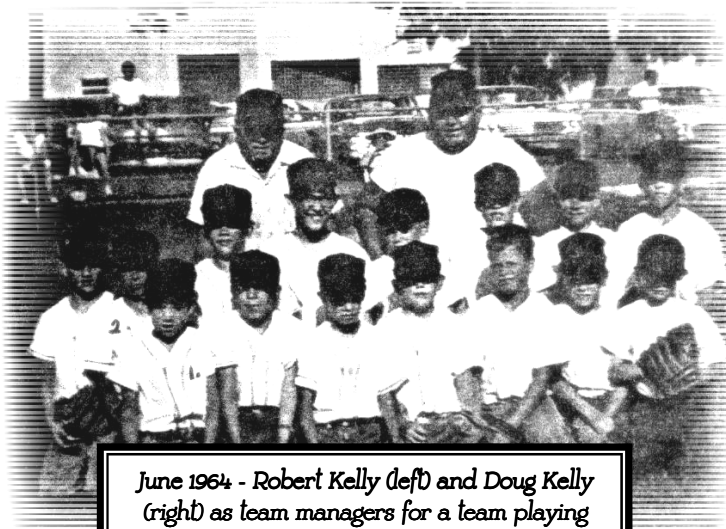


DOUG KELLY FIELD DEDICATION

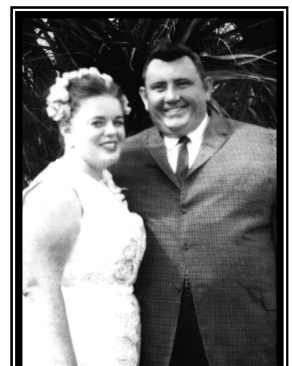

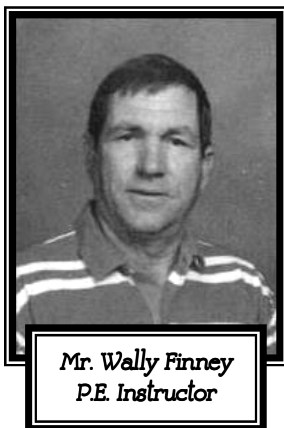


Honoree Information

Wally Finney graduated from Merritt Island High School in 1966, a member of the first graduating class. After college, he taught Physical Education at Audubon Elementary School from 1970-1981. With his own children beginning school at Tropical Elementary, he transferred there to teach Physical Education from 1981 until 2005 when he retired. For the 25 years he was at Tropical, he was able to help maintain and upgrade the baseball facilities located here behind the school.

Although he umpired some at North Merritt Island little league, he has always taken a special interest in South Merritt Island little league. He shared the vision along with Mr. Ron Smith and Mr. Doug Kelly to provide the children of South Merritt Island with the best possible facilities. He has been involved on the S.M.I.L.L. board as Player Agent, has officiated games, led clinics, managed, and coached. He also served on the Brevard County Parks and Recreation Department's Referendum Projects Committee for Baseball and Softball from 2001-2002 to help guide the development of the new facilities we dedicate today.

Currently, his love for the game (and his desire to give back to an organization that helped him) is demonstrated by his willingness to officiate games and share coaching/teaching experiences with our youth to help them become better individuals who are prepared to conquer life's challenges.

In addition, the Merritt Island little league Board of Directors wishes to extend the title of Honorary Board Member to Mr. Wally Finney.

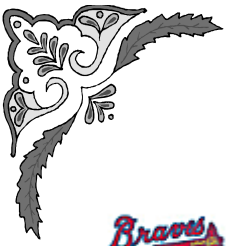


A Message from Mr. Finney

South Merritt Island All-Stars complete story-book summer

Expectations weren't very high for the South Merritt Island 9-10 year-olds all-star baseball team, but by the end of the season, they proved to be the little team that could.

South Merritt Island coach Dom Dipasquale was proud of his team after their heartbreaking 5-4 loss in the District 22 championship game against Rockledge.

"This is the best team I've ever worked with," he said. "They're like my own version of the dream team. We had the most extraordinary season and nobody counted on us going this far."

South Merritt Island's team was composed of the top players from the South Merritt Island Little League, which represents players who live south of State Road 520 in Merritt Island.

The team's roster included coach Dipasquale's son, Dominick, along with Daniel Bowman, Mickey Demorat, Nick Smith, Chris Redwine, Gavin Lacourse, Nick Zeak, Alex Robertson, Mike Owens, Victor Rahne, Jimmy Dixon and Garrett Betty.

South Merritt Island finished the season with two dramatic games.

In the semifinal, they played rival North Merritt Island and entered the final inning trailing by eight runs. In dramatic fashion, they produced nine runs in one inning for the 11-10 win and advanced to the championship game.

The final game was just as intense. Six innings weren't enough to decide the game, and both teams entered the seventh inning tied at 4.

Rockledge won on a base hit in the bottom of the seventh and Merritt Island's season was over.

Coach Dipasquale reassured his team of their success before they left the field for the final time.

"You guys had a great game out there tonight," he said. "Just think of how great next year will be."

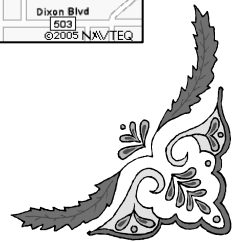
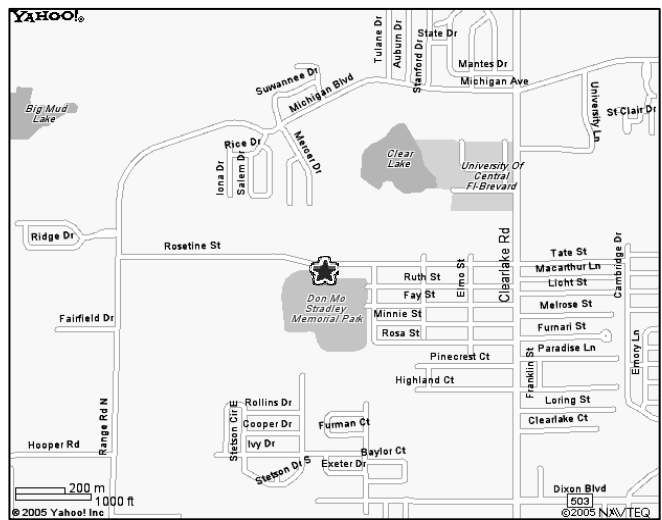
